Private Homes at One&Only Le Saint Geran, are crafted for a very demanding clientele and require an extremely detailed design coordination.

Each and every piece of equipment was meticulously customized.

A Show Villa was delivered in only 3 months; a serious challenge considering the level of accuracy in production needed, transportation times and complex importing regulations in Mauritius, while controlling the budget.

We had to balance the requirements of a large scale tender in anticipation of the 52 villas to be further built, while at the time, buying only 1 piece of each item and without the possibility to confirm timing and further quantities to suppliers.

To deliver this project to the complete client satisfaction, we had to allocate more resources than normally needed for such a project scale.

Our Project Manager and Managing Director ensured a very close coordination internally as well as with the client.

One of our highly qualified designers was assigned to supervise all items requiring custom production, while a specialist was focusing on logistics arrangements to keep a high processing pace.

Close vendors' management was required to ensure timely and impeccable execution of all orders, while keeping vendors motivated in absence of confirmed large orders.

Very quick execution, ability to change plan and reorganize in a very agile manner were key to this project success.

Tsinandali Estate is the cradle of classical wine making of Georgia, the place where Georgian wine was first bottled. Located in the heartland of wine producing region of Kakheti it was among domains of Chavchavadze princely family for centuries, and most notably of Prince Alexander Chavchavadze (1786-1846) poet, public benefactor and military figure.

The Radisson Collection Tsinandali is was unique project with a very challenging set of requirements, to meet all operational standards and international luxury hospitality requirements, while preserving the integrity of the historical estate.

The heritage building demanded special attention to materials used to, all monitored by government officials and restoration experts. Besides, Public Areas fit out had to be managed solely from art direction from famous lighting designer Ingo Maurer and Georgian artist Tamara Kzesitadze.

The project required a special team to manage the intricate design. We mobilized **our Design and FF&E specialists to develop a complete specification book based the two Art Directors' visions**.

To meet the requirement for authenticity while keeping with the budget, we sourced most of the Public Areas furniture and various lighting fixtures on antique markets and in auction houses. CPM identified the most suitable markets and organized trips with designers and client during which unique pieces were hand picked. Once an item was chosen by the designers, we would reserve it and come back to negotiate the best prices with antiquaries and private owners piece by piece.

Orders management, financial tracking and export was particularly complex as most vendors would accept only cash payments without receipts and would not provide the required documents for international transport, let alone suitable packing for export. An extensive logistic and administrative effort was deployed to successfully gather over a 130 unique pieces from France, Belgium, Sweden, Turkey, Iran and India, and deliver them in a consolidated fashion to Georgia.

The hotel successfully opened in 2018 and has since received many awards including "Best Hotel & Tourism Resort Award" finalist MIPIM2020 for its unique handcrafted interiors, outstanding premium lifestyle facilities, its character and authenticity.








































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
